Presentations; Clare Graham & Suzy Mercer were present to represent Foundation Scotland & gave a full introduction to all present as to the role Foundation Scotland played in administering the community benefit funds. There were 3 community councils that required elections & also the Blue Book should be published shortly.

Planning matters; none to report but a question was asked to the progress of Knock Dhu wind farm. This was discussed but more investigation was required. David Hall reported that he had been in contact with various planning officers & designers regarding the proposed play park on Pinmore green. He would keep the council updated.

Road matters; David Hall reported that he had been in contact with S A C in regard to this & plans were being made for "signing & lining". Also a tree was reported to be down on the road crash barrier in Pinwherry but had been removed now, also the 20 mph flashing sign wasn't working.

Anne asked if it was possible to have quarterly fund statements for Foundation Scotland & Community Council.
