Planning & licencing report; Nothing to report

Treasurer report; David Hall reported that funds were at £14,428.08 after a cancelled cheque at £169.50 & a Foundation Scotland grant of £2,000 coming into the account. Also he raised that a letter had been received from Amy Dee Watson regarding the maintenance of the Pinmore play park. This money was thought to have been budgeted for during construction. It was decided to ask for breakdown of costs etc compared to money granted for the project.

Correspondence; Letter received from Blake Hatfield from Stanley Wright regarding a proposed new woodland creation on Pinwherry hill. The site will extend to 126Ha at the top for Pinwherry hill. The proposed extraction route would be a farm track down the hill onto the U26 then C45 before joining the B734 through Colmonell. Maps were circulated. Letter also received from South Ayrshire Council regarding the licencing of sexual entertainment venues (SEVs). The consultation period being from 30th August 2024 till 11th October 2024.
