Police report; Police report was there that there was no incidents.

Presentations: Kevin Braidwood from SAC roads department attended. Firstly the Pinmore 20 mph issue, this was scheduled to be done but would be "signing & lining", no hard engineering works. Pinmore bus stop was also raised, as lots of school children cross the A714 at "bus times". This was promised to be looked at. The muck road resurface was next, this was scheduled for the coming financial year as money ran out in the previous year. The C13 Assel road was raised about resurfacing, this was not scheduled but Kevin explained that all roads in SAC were assessed around September time & were "ranked" regarding condition, usage, traffic flow etc. All scheduled road works could be seen on the ARA website. Also the footpath within Pinwherry was scheduled.

Audry Gatt was also in attendance from the SAC place planning team to explain what they could do for us & what is available to the communities. She explained what could be taken from the original survey & said we could renew the survey, but it was the opinion of the council to stick to the original. Council agreed to decide what issues we wanted to deal with at the next meeting.

Elected member report; Alec Clark reported that the Quay Zone damage was extensive & repairs were estimated to take 2 years. While most of the equipment from it has been put in storage the Girvan community centre was being prepared for use & Maybole pool was being used for some of the clubs, classes etc. SAC budget had been announced & possible extra charges for brown bin collections would be made.
