Resilience Project

Pinwherry and Pinmore Community Development Trust secured funding to install an emergency generator at The Auld School Community Centre. In the event of a prolonged power outage the Community Centre will be opened to allow charging of devices, hot drinks and somewhere warm for people to gather. The Community Centre will also be the focal point of any emergency planning or action to be taken within the community in the event of widespread emergency disruption.

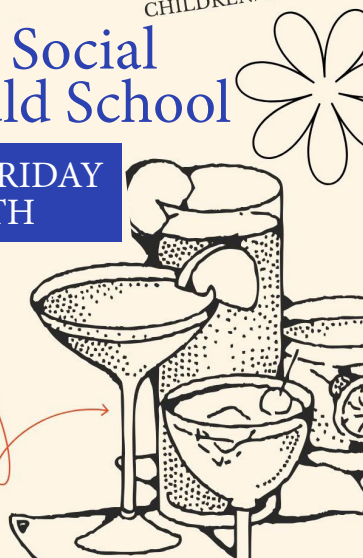
